YOUNG TEAM PROJECT CALL

Addressees: all researchers from AIM, APC, IPGP and ONERA.

As suggested by our Scientific Committee in 2013, the UnivEarthS Labex calls for a new young scientific team, to start in 2015.

This call aims at financing a young permanent researcher to support him/her to develop his/her research activity and to create a new team. Each submitted project must meet the following requirements:

- young permanent researcher means someone who is currently working (associate professor or research fellow equivalent...) and does not have a A rank. There is no age limit or limit due to the duration of the employment contract.
- develop a research topic which is ambitious and completely innovative worldwide or within France
- need to constitute a team and/or buy equipment
- a support statement from the host laboratory to begin this new project

Interdisciplinary projects are encouraged but not obligatory.

The deadline to submit the research proposal is the 22nd of September, 2014 at 12pm.

Maximum grant: 150 000 € total (consumables, equipement and hiring).

Project duration: 2 or 3 years (2015-2016 or 2015-2017)

Applications will be first examined for eligibility by the UnivEarthS Executive Board (September 24th), then, for the final decision, by the Scientific Committee of the Labex on October 17th. The Scientific Committee will judge the new project and decide on its incorporation (or not) in the overall budget, at the expense of other existing projects.
